#### What is Grace?

- Unmerited favor
  - —To be pleased with, and therefore to bless or show kindness toward

#### What is Grace?

- Unmerited favor
  - Given purely at the discretion of the giver
  - -Example: Ezek. 16:1-14

# Why Do We Need Grace?

- Before the Fall, man was innocent
- When Adam sinned, man was guilty
- When Christ died, man could be justified

# Why Do We Need Grace?

- Justified
  - -Declared righteous in the eyes of the law
  - –You do nothing! "being justified as a gift by His grace" (Rom. 3:24)

## **God Provides Righteousness**

 "He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." (2 Cor. 5:21)

## **God Provides Righteousness**

 "I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly." (Gal. 2:21)

#### **God Provides Righteousness**

• "For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast." (Eph. 2:8-9)

### **God Provides Righteousness**

- Grace and Grits
- Grace gives us what we do not have in ourselves at no cost to us

# **God Provides Righteousness**

- Grace sets biblical Christianity apart from every other religion
  - All man-made religions require some effort from man toward God
  - –Grace shows us it is all of God!

#### What Does Grace Do?

- Saves us: by grace through faith (Eph. 2:8-9)
  - -Available to all
  - -Given to the humble (1 Pet. 5:5)

#### What Does Grace Do?

- Preserves us: we stand in grace; disproportionate to sin (Rom. 5)
- Sustains us: it is sufficient (2 Cor. 12:7-10)
- Teaches us: live godly (Titus 2:11-14)

#### What Does Grace Do?

- Empowers us: labor in grace (1 Cor. 15:10)
- Equips us: spiritual gifts (Rom. 12:3)

- Humble yourself 2 Sam. 15:25-26
