 Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.




Context of James

- Tests reveal what you know/believe
- Whether He causes them or allows them, God uses trials to reveal to us how well we truly understand and do what we say we believe

James 3:1-12

- Test #3 How well do you control your tongue?
 - -The immature have no control
 - —The mature have more control (neck trained)



James 3:13-18

- 1. The Challenge (13)
- 2. The Contrast (14-18)
 - A. Earthly Wisdom (Immature Man)
 - B. Godly Wisdom (Mature Man)

- Who among you is wise and understanding?
 - -Hint of sarcasm?
 - -Were some boasting of their great wisdom and insight? (see v. 5)

- Wise and understanding
 - —Not intellectual: high IQ; smart; clever; able to solve riddles
 - -Moral: *choosing* to *do* what is good and right (as when in trials 1:2-5)

- Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom
- You say you have wisdom; show us your wisdom by your works.' (cf. 2:18)
- Vindicated by all her children (Lk. 7:35)

- Good <u>behavior</u>
 - -conduct (1 Tim. 4:12); manner of life (Eph. 4:22) [effectual doer 1:25]
- his deeds
 - -works (2:14, 17, 18-26)

- in the gentleness of wisdom
 - -meekness (1:21)
 - Power under control; submission from a position of strength
 - Matt. 27:11-14; 1 Pet. 2:21-23

James 3:13-18

- The Challenge: 'You say you have wisdom; show us your wisdom by your works.'
- The Contrast...

- Bitter jealousy cruel envy or malice
- Selfish ambition contention;
 partisanship; factions; promoting
 ones own party / agenda / ideas
- In your heart (1:26; 2:4)

- Arrogant boast (3:5), self-promoting
- Lie against the truth claiming faith and wisdom but showing jealousy and partisanship is lying against the truth of the gospel (1:18, 26; 2:1-4)

- Does not come down from above
 –Not a gift (1:5) from God (1:17)
- Earthly of human origin; consumed with man-centered goals, priorities
 - -1 Cor. 1:20-24; 2:5-7; Phil. 3:17-21

- Natural from *psyche* (*soul*): man's unregenerate nature (1 Cor. 2:14)
- Demonic either characteristic of or proceeding from demons (1 Tim. 4:1)

- Disorder unsettled, restless (3:8);
 confusion (vs peace 1 Cor. 14:33)
- Every evil thing better: every goodfor-nothing practice; worthless deeds that distract from what is important

- The wisdom from above
 - -A gift (1:5) from God (1:17)
 - -Essential to the Christian life (Eph. 1:17-19; Phil. 1:9-11; Col. 1:9-12)
 - How to live out God's will

- Pure free from defilement or impurity (like Christ - 1 John 3:2-3)
 - -Wisdom avoids evil (Prov. 3:7; 8:12-13; 16:6)
 - -Unstained by the world (1:27)

 First / then – logical or essential order: as we pursue inner purity, the rest will flow out of it (e.g. - Prov. 16:7)

- Peaceable averse to conflict, peaceloving (Heb. 12:11)
- Gentle fair, patient, mild (1 Tim. 3:3)
- Reasonable easily persuaded, i.e. –
 willing to learn from others/teachable

 Full of mercy and good fruits – not compassion alone but with practical application (2:13-17; works 3:13)

- Unwavering without division; no duplicity (i.e. - 3:9-12)
- Without hypocrisy genuine; free from pretense; sincere; wysiwyg

- The seed whose fruit is righteousness
 - -Better: the fruit of [produced by] righteousness is sown in peace
 - -Phil. 1:9-11; Heb. 12:11
 - -Showing (13) and sowing (18)

So What?

- This wisdom is the character of Christ
 - -The Gospels
 - -The Beatitudes (Matt. 5:3-11)
 - -Love (1 Cor. 13:4-7)
 - -Wisdom (Prov. 1-3)

So What?

- This wisdom is the character of Christ
- This is the character that God is working to produce in all believers (1:2-4; Rom. 5:3-5)

So What?

- God calls us to work with Him
 - -Pursue sanctification (Rom. 6)
 - -Pursue wisdom (Prov. 2)
 - -Put on the new man remade in the image of Christ (Col. 3:9-10)
 - -Show works (good behavior) (3:13)
