- His will against God's will

The Motivation

Isaiah 14:13-14 (NASB)

13 "But you said in your heart, 'I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, and I will sit on the mount of assembly in the recesses of the north. 14 'I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High.'

The Motivation

- The Five I wills
 - Ascend to heaven: Take God's place
 - Raise my throne above the stars: authority over the angels
 - Sit on the mount: to steal territory that belongs only to God
 - Ascend above the clouds: above the glory of God
 - Make myself like the Most High: to be like God.

The Consequences

- Disruption of harmony: opposition to God
- Lucifer joined by other angels and the human race
- One plan (God's) became millions, driven by personal ambition (Self)
- Rule of God opposed at every quarter

God's Response

- God decided to use Lucifer (now Satan)
 - Satan given rulership of this world
 - The ruler of this world has no power over me. But he's coming, so I won't talk with you much longer. (Jn 14:30)
 - Satan given time to be successful
 - God would not be compromised but win a moral and spiritual victory
