Vs. 30-31 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. He has no claim on me, but I do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father.

• Jesus' obedience to the Father set an example for us! (John 5:19-20)

• John 15:10

If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love.

• 1 John 2:3-4

And by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him...

• 1 John 3:24

Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us.

• 2 John 6

And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it.

Revelation 12:17

Then the dragon became furious with the woman and went off to make war on the rest of her offspring, on those who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus...

Revelation 14:12

Here is a call for the endurance of the saints, those who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.

- The Holy Spirit is the Helper (Vs. 16-20; 25-27)
  - Literally the HS is one "who comes along side of." (Vs. 16)
  - He is the continued presence of Jesus, who will never leave (Vs. 16)
  - He Enabled the Disciple to Obey (John 14:13-14; Acts 1:1, 8)

- He is the Spirit of Truth (Vs. 17)
  - Vs. 6 Jesus is the Truth
  - Luke 22:20, "And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."

Ezekiel 36:26-27

And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.

Jeremiah 31:33

For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

- Vs. 26 "He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you."
  - He will bear witness to Jesus (15:26)
  - He will convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment (16:8-11)
  - He will guide the disciples into all Truth (16:13)

- This is a promise of the inspiration of the NT.
  - 2 Peter 1:16-21
- "Any movement claiming the possession of the Spirit, which glorifies the Spirit instead of Christ is alien to the teaching of Jesus about the Spirit." -Donald Guthrie

- Practical Philip
- Vs. 8 "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us."
- Jesus rebukes Philip
  - Worth (vs. 9-10)
  - Words (vs. 10)
  - Works (vs. 11)

- Vs. 21 "Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him."
- Emphanizo: to make known, to make plain, to reveal, to bring to the light, to disclose, revelation.

- Vs. 22 Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, "Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?"
- Judas (not Iscariot) and not Insightful!

- Vs. 17 "The world cannot receive the HS because it neither sees him nor knows him."
- Vs. 19 "The world will see me no more, but you will see me."
- Vs. 27 "Not as the world gives do I give to you."

Vs. 23 Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him."

- You in Christ John 15:4-5
- You in the Father John 17:21
  - Vs. 3 He is going to prepare a place for them.
  - Vs. 23 God is going to dwell within them.

- He shifts from saying "Keep my commandments" (Vs. 15, 21 to "Keep my words." (Vs. 23, 24)
- Vs. 24 "Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me."

- "The Gospel message in its total unity, and not as broken up into separate commands (v. 15), or separate parts (v. 24)." -Brooke Wescott
- More of God in your life is connected to more obedience to His Word.

- "I knew that God communicated with me through the Bible, but I yearned for more. Increasingly, I wanted to hear what God had to say to me personally on a given day." -Sarah Young
- We think we will have a greater revelation of God if we have His Word and
