A Childlike Faith And Adult Walk

Matt 18:3-4 – Become like a child "Truly I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoever then humbles himself as this child, he is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven."

A Childlike Faith
Matt. 19:13-15; Mark 10:13-16; Luke 18:15-17
Recognize inadequacy

Humility, expectancy
Trust / total dependence

Childlike = Childish? God wants us to come to Him in childlike humility and dependence But He also wants us to grow up

A Childish Faith?
Telos: the end, termination, or goal
Teleios: having attained the end or purpose: *fully developed, mature*

A Childish Faith? •Matt 5:48 - Therefore you are to be perfect [teleios], as your heavenly Father is perfect [*teleios*]. •God wants us to be mature •God wants us to be like Him

Childish vs Mature1 Cor. 2:1-7

I came to you with a simple message: Jesus Christ, and Him crucified •Yet we do speak wisdom among those who are mature [teleios] (wisdom = the 'depths of God' - v.10)

Childish vs Mature 1 Cor. 3:1-4 Infants [*nepios*] – babe, child, simple, unlearned

INFANTS MILK SIMPLE TRUTHS **NOT READY** "FLESHLY" JEALOUSY/QUARRELS ACT LIKE MERE MEN

MATURE SOLID FOOD **DEEP TRUTHS** READY "SPIRITUAL" [AGAPE] [ACT LIKE CHRIST]

Childish vs Mature Maturity is connected with truth Able to grasp & understand (3:2) •Able to apply / use (3:3) Affects attitude and behavior

Childish vs Mature •Eph. 4:11-19 INFANTS MATURE TOSSED / CARRIED GROUNDED GULLIBLE SPEAK TRUTH LIVING LIKE UNSAVED LIVING LIKE CHRIST

Childish vs Mature Maturity is connected with knowledge •Able to discern truth from error (14) •Exhort / encourage one another (15) •Able to apply / use (16) Affects attitude and behavior (17ff)

Expositor's Bible Commentary "Paul contrasts the deception of heresy with the integrity of the gospel. The church cannot allow falsehood to go uncorrected, yet the truth must always be vindicated in the accents of love....

Expositor's Bible Commentary "Speaking the truth' ... is strictly 'doing the truth' and may imply more than verbalization. This fundamental concern for the truth is the secret of maturity in the church."

Childish vs Mature •Heb. 5:14-6:12 •Dull of hearing – better: *sluggish or* lazy in comprehending (see 6:12) •Ought – indebted: obligated, it is proper or fitting

Childish vs Mature Maturity is connected with knowledge •Able to discern truth from error (5:14) •Able to teach one another (5:12) •Able to apply / use (5:14) •Able to handle God's Word (5:13)

Howard Hendricks "Solid food is for the mature. Who are the mature? Are they the people who go to seminary? Who can whip anyone in a theological duel? Who know the most Bible verses? ...

Howard Hendricks "No, the writer says you are mature if you've trained yourself through constant use of Scripture to distinguish good from evil. The mark of spiritual maturity is not how much you understand, but how much you use. ...

Howard Hendricks "In the spiritual realm, the opposite of ignorance is not knowledge but obedience."

Spiritual Maturity Learn to cut your own steak •Can you handle the truth? •Study it yourself! – 2 Tim. 2:15 •*Premastication*? •What do you consume?

Do Not Be Led Astray You cannot trust everything at the "Christian" bookstore You cannot trust everything from a certain author, teacher, preacher •We must learn to discern the actual content of what is being said

Do Not Be Led Astray Just because someone uses a Bible verse does not mean they used it correctly •Just because something "works" does not mean it is right (e.g. –Jeremiah 44) •Whatever is said must line up with what has been revealed in God's Word

Spiritual Maturity Listen to one another Col. 1:28-29 – admonish and teach •Col. 3:16 – teach and admonish Admonish = instruct, counsel, warn, inculcate (instill, beat, pound, repeat, say over and over, indoctrinate)

Spiritual Maturity Labor in prayer for one another •Col. 4:12-13 •Deep concern Maturity & assurance of God's will

Spiritual Maturity Let endurance do its work •James 1 •Be faithful in the tests of life (2-4) •Be doers of the Word (22-25) •Blessed is the man who perseveres (12)

Spiritual Maturity Acting like God (e.g. – Jesus Christ) Requires knowing God Requires knowing what God is like Requires choosing to do it Requires choosing to do it constantly
