Does God have Emotion?

What we are <u>NOT</u> talking about:

 Anthropomorphism: the attribution of human characteristics to a god, animal or object

What we ARE talking about:

- Character Expression
- Unchangedness (Immutability)

Let's Look in the Book:

- God *Hates* (Deut. 12:31, Ps. 11:5)
- God is Compassionate (Gen 19:16, 2 Chr 30:9)
- God *Grieves* (Gen 6:6, John 11:35)
- God is *Joyful* (Neh 8:10, Zeph 3:17)
- God *Delights* (Gen 1:31, Ps 147:10-11,

Prov. 11:20)

So, Does God have Emotion?

God's **emotion** is an expression of His character and always <u>active</u> or <u>proactive</u> as toward His creation.

God does NOT <u>respond</u> or <u>react</u> "emotionally" (RE: Webster, APA) to His creation.

And What About Us?

Romans 12:4-6

"Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. We have different gifts, according to the grace given us."

One Body... Many Members

Romans 12:9-16

"Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, (cont.)

Romans 12:9-16

Faithful in prayer. Share with God's people who are in need. Practice hospitality. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. (cont.)

Romans 12:9-16

Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited."

Conformed or Transformed?

Romans 12:2

"Be not conformed"

BUT

"Be transformed"

So, Do We Have Emotions?

CONFORMED:

Buy into the pattern of this world that **emotions** are involuntary responses to outside influences.

TRANSFORMED:

Godly **emotions** are an expression of our new character reflecting the One whose image we bear.

Transformed Emotions

- Purposeful Expression of our Identity
 - "Rejoice with those who rejoice..."
