2:6-7 Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude.

The Person of the Son (14-20) •'Image of the invisible God' (15) •Man was made in the image of God Intended to be God's self-expression Jesus is the image of God God's full & complete self-expression •He fills both God's and man's roles

The Person of the Son (14-20) •'the firstborn of all creation' (15) •First born but not nec. born first Rank/position, supremacy, authority Israel (Ex. 4:22); David('s Heir) (Ps. 89:27)

The Person of the Son (14-20) 'in' 'through' 'to' Christ (16) Mediator of creation (John 1:3; Heb. 1:2) •Cf. Prov. 8:22-36 Sustainer of creation (Heb. 1:3) Purpose of creation (1 Cor. 15:20-28; Eph. 1:22-23; Rev. 1:8; Phil. 2:9-11)

The Person of the Son (14-20) •'the firstborn from the dead' (18) Not the first to be raised from the dead The first to have a resurrection body Immortal, incorruptible (1 Cor. 15) He has authority over life and death •Rev. 1:17-18; John 5:28-29; Heb. 2:14

Their Past
You were formerly alienated'
Estranged, separate
Eph. 2:12; 4:18



Their Past
You were formerly hostile in mind'
Antagonistic in your intentions
Gen. 6:5; Rom. 1:21-32; 8:1-17; Eph. 4:17-19

 Their Past 'engaged in evil deeds' Outward expressions of the intentions •Mirrors the spiral of 1:9-10 Wrong thinking leads to sin, which leads to further wrong thinking...

 Their Present •'He has now reconciled you' Enemies brought together •'in His fleshly body through death' •Substitute offering (v 20; Rom. 8:3) •Attacking the heresy...

 False Teaching "Physical / material is bad" "Spiritual / immaterial is good" •Paul You were hostile in thoughts – bad! Jesus had a physical body – good!

 Their Future 'Holy, blameless and beyond reproach' These things are true of Christ, and they are 'in Christ' (Eph. 1:4) In the mean time, sanctification (from position to practice)

How they get there
'if indeed you continue in the faith'
Better: *since* you continue (see 3:1)
Holding to sound doctrine indicates true spiritual condition (2 John 7-11)

 How they get there Holding to sound doctrine •1 Tim. 1:3-11; 4:1-16; 6:3-5; 2 Tim. 4:1-5; Titus 1:9; 2:1 Heresy is deceptive •Eph. 4:14-16; 2 Pet. 2:1-3; Jude

How they get there
'not moved away from the hope of the gospel'

'firmly established and steadfast'
Evidenced by their faith and love (4-5)
