

- Sunday: Triumphal Entry / Palm Sunday
- Monday: cleansing of the temple
- Tuesday: Mental Chess
 - Chief priests, scribes, elders (Sanhedrin)
 - Pharisees & Herodians
 - New Challenger: The Sadducees

- •Who are the Sadducees?
 - Party of the high priests
 - •Not overly religious used as a tool for power and profit (e.g. temple, 11:15)
 - Political; upper-crust; snooty/rude
 - Hellenized & catering to Rome

- •What did the Sadducees believe?
 - No resurrection (18)
 - •No supernatural (except God) (Acts 23:8)
 - Focused on the Pentateuch
 - Did not recognize oral law or traditions (as did the Pharisees)

- •Deut. 25:5-10 Levirate Marriage
 - Continue family name and property
 - "When brothers live together" their inheritance has not yet been divided? (e.g. – Luke 15:11-12)
 - Refusal brings shame / disgrace (selfish?)

- •Straw Man: a caricature of your opponent's argument that is easier to knock down
- •Example: "Evolutionists believe we evolved from monkeys."
 - Disproving we evolved from monkeys does not disprove evolution

- •"You are mistaken" (led astray, deceived)
 - You do not understand the Scriptures
 - You do not understand the power of God
- •Straw Man: Jesus believed in resurrection, but not in marriage after resurrection (25)
 - Without that, their argument crumbles

- "have you not read...?" (26)
 - "in the book of Moses" (Pentateuch!)
 - •"I am the God of Abraham and the God •They are living after death checkmate!

So What?

- •Do I know the Scriptures?
 - •2 Tim. 3:14-17; 1 Pet. 2:1-3; 2 Pet. 1:2-11
 - •Do I think about what I'm reading?
- •Do I know the power of God?
 - •Example: Mark 5:35-43
- •Am I projecting my thoughts on God?

- One of the scribes (28; Matt. 22:35)
- Because Jesus answered the Sadducees well
- •"What commandment is the foremost of all?" (28; cf. Luke 10:25-29)
 - •Two paths: hairsplitting or summarizing
 - •He was thinking about it!

- •Deut. 6:4-5; Lev. 19:18
 - •Summed up in one word: LOVE (Rom. 13:9-10; 1 Cor. 13; Gal. 5:14; James 2:8)
 - Covers the 10 Commandments
 - Encompasses man's relationships
 - •Demands the whole of man (8:34-38)

- Not parts, but the whole of man
- •"Right" Good! Beautiful! Well done! (32)
- Heart, understanding, strength (33)
 - •Mark 4:12; 6:52; 7:14; 8:17, 21
- "much more than all burnt offerings and sacrifices" (see 1 Sam. 15:22)

- When Jesus saw that he had answered intelligently (as possessing discernment)
 - •"The Teacher saw that the man had answered wisely, that is, as a person who had a mind and used it to good advantage." (William Hendriksen)



- "You are not far from the kingdom of God"
 - A compliment and an appeal
 - Not far, but not there yet
 - He needed to recognize Jesus as Messiah and believe in Him (cf. Acts 16:31)

So What?

- •Do I love God with all of me?
- •Do I love others as much as/in the same way as I love myself?
- "Yeah, but we can't do that perfectly"
 - •Am I closer than I was before?
 - Sanctification is a process (2 Pet. 1:5-11)

- After that, no one would venture to ask Him any more questions (34b)
- •Now it's His turn (35)
 - •Call all the scribes/Pharisees (Matt. 22:41) to think deeply about the Word of God and the Messiah

- •How is Christ the son of David?
 - Prevailing theory: Son of David ->
 Messiah -> political savior (see 11:10)
 - •God promised a *physical descendent* of David would be King in Jerusalem (2 Sam. 7:8-17; Isa. 9:7; Jer. 23:5)


- "David himself said in the Holy Spirit..." (see 2 Pet. 1:20-21)
 - •Ps. 110:1 "YHWH said to my Adonai" (i.e.
 - the Messiah: vv. 4-7)
 - •How can an only-human descendent of David also be David's Lord?
 - •Acts 2:22-36; Rom. 1:3-4; cf. Heb. 1:13

- •They recognized Ps. 110 as Messianic
- •Dilemma (re: Adonai):
 - Horn 1: Messiah is God
 - Horn 2: Messiah is God and Man
- Yet they condemned Jesus for making these very claims! (e.g. - Mark 2:1-12)

- •"Beware of the scribes" (38; Matt. 23:1-39)
 - •Beware: look away from, avoid (see 8:15)
- •"who" (the ones) a certain type of scribe
 - Like to be seen and honored by men
- •"who devour widows' houses" con-men
 - Pray hypocritically fake super-piety

- •Breaktime: Jesus was people-watching (41)
- Treasury: 13 Trumpets 7 for temple needs,
 6 for freewill offerings
- Observing how... (manner, in what way)
 - •Many rich put in many coins
 - •100 \$1 bills vs. 1 \$100 bill

- A poor widow with 2 copper coins
 - •1/64 of a denarius (day's wage)
 - •\$7.25 x 8 hrs = \$58 \div 64 = \$0.91
 - All she had to live on! (-> fasting)
 - •The rich gave out of their surplus
- Not the amount but the attitude! (43)



So What?

- Do I accurately handle the word of truth?
 (2 Tim. 2:15)
 - Study it, know it, understanding it, memorize it, think/reflect on it, reason from it...
 - •In order to live it out (James 1:22-25)
