

Prolegomena

•OT background: Isaiah; Jer. 30; Ezek. 28-39; Dan. 7, 9-12; Joel 2-3; Zech. 12-14; et. al. Partial & ultimate; immediate & future •For example: Isa. 9:6-7 Some foreshadowing; several partial fulfillments; but not all yet fully fulfilled

Prolegomena •The Tribulation is for Israel, not the Church (Dan. 9:24-27; 12:1 -> your people) •Time of Jacob's distress/trouble (Jer. 30:7) •The disciples did not understand The Church or the church age •Jesus revealed sequence but not timing

The Setting (1-4) •What wonderful stones and buildings! (1) Herod's Temple (recreated Solomon's) •Construction: 19 BC – AD 63 •Some stones 37.5' l x 18' w x 12' h weighed as much as 100 tons Outside overlaid with gold

The Setting (1-4)

•Not one stone will be left upon another (2) •Disciples' question: When and What sign? •They still believed Jesus would set up His kingdom immediately (cf. Acts 1:6-7) •Jesus' answer had both near and far implications

Characteristics of the End 1. Deception (5-8) •False messiahs (6; Rev. 6:1-2) •Many will come in My name Many will be led astray •Apostasy (2 Thess. 2); fall away (1 Tim. 4); turn away (2 Tim. 4:1-5)

Characteristics of the End 1. Deception (5-8) •False messiahs (6; Rev. 6:1-2) •Frightening news (7-8; Rev. 6:3-8) •Wars, earthquakes, famines •Beginning of birth pangs (Jer. 30:6-7; Isa. 13:6-13; 1 Thess. 5:2-3)





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A new study suggests that we may want to brace for a surge of quakes in the year ahead Q

Characteristics of the End 2. Danger (9-13) The apostles and martyrs (Rev. 6:9-11) •Deliver to the courts, flog in the synagogues, stand before kings •E.g. - Acts 4:1-22; 2 Cor. 11:24 Endure -> saved? (see Rev. 2:10)

Characteristics of the End 3. Destruction (14-23) Abomination of desolation (Dan. 9:27; 11:31; 12:11; Matt. 24:15) Defilement / profanation -> Antichrist •E.g. - Antiochus Epiphanes, 167 BC •Where it should not be – Holy of Holies

Characteristics of the End •Not one stone will be left upon another (2) • AD 66 – Jews rebelled against Rome • AD 70 – Titus (son of Emperor Vespasian) besieged and then destroyed Jerusalem Temple was destroyed by fire; soldiers moved stones to collect melted gold

The Signs of the Reappearance of the Twelfth Imam (ajtf) The Signs of the Reappearance (Qiyam) of the (Imam) who undertakes the Office (al-Qa'im), Peace be on him, the Period of Time of his Appearance, an Explanation of his Life and an Extract of what is revealed about his State.

Traditions have been reported mentioning the signs for the time of the appearance of the Imam who will arise (qa'im), peace be on him, and the events which will take place before his appearance, together with the indications and features of it.


Among them are: The Sufyani will come out in revolt; the Hasanid will be killed; the Abbasids will dispute over worldly kingdom; there will be an eclipse of the sun in the middle of the month of Ramadan; there will be an eclipse of the moon at the end of that month in contrast to ordinary happenings; the land will be swallowed up at al-Bayda'; it will be swallowed in the east-it will be swallowed up in the west; the sun will stay still from the time of its decline to the middle of the time for the afternoon prayer.

It will rise from the west; a pure soul (nafs zakiyya) will be killed in the outskirts of Kufa with seventy righteous men; a Hashimite will be slaughtered between the corner (of the Ka'ba) and the station of Abraham); the wall of the mosque of Kufa will be destroyed;

Characteristics of the End 5. Disclosure (26-27) Then they will see the Son of Man •Second Coming (Dan. 7:13; Zech. 12:10-14; 14:4; Acts 1:11) •Armageddon (Zech. 12:1-9; 14:1-5; Joel 3:9-17; Rev. 19:11-21)

Characteristics of the End •Gather His elect from the four winds (27) Israel was God's elect (e.g. - Deut. 7:6) •Remnant within Israel (Isa. 65:7-25) God scattered Israel to the four winds (Ezek. 5:10, 12; 17:21; Zech. 2:6) •Promised to gather (Isa. 11:11-12; 27:13)

Summary Mark 13 points to the culmination of God's plan for Israel God will fulfill His promises to Abraham (Gen. 15; 17; 22) and David (2 Sam. 7) (cf. Rom. 11:26-36)

So What? God is sovereign over all human history He declares the end from the beginning (Isa. 46:8-11)

We can rest in confident assurance that He is in control of all things!
He is worthy of our faith (2 Tim. 2:13)

So What?

 We should look for Jesus' imminent return (1 Cor. 1:7; 15:51-52; Phil. 3:20; 1 Thess. 1:10; Titus 2:13; Rev. 3:11; 22:7, 12, 17, 20) And we should act accordingly (Matt. 28:19-20; James 5:7-9; 1 John 2:28) Even so, come, Lord Jesus!
