- 1. The Man of God's:
- Focus: Run vigorously away from simand run diligently toward holiness
- Fight: preach the unadulterated truth; fulfill your ministry; don't shrink or shirk
- Foundation: live out your eternal life now

- 1. The Man of God's Faithfulness
- •I charge you
  - To pass on an announcement;
    to advance an order or command
    - •Instruct(ion) (1:3, 5; 6:17), prescribe (4:11; 5:7), command (1:18)
    - The correct course of action
    - Binding, expected; duty

1. The Man of God's Faithfulness

•I charge you

•In the presence of — in the face of, in the sight of, before

•God and Christ Jesus — as witnesses to the charge and its execution (cf. 5:21; 2 Tim. 4:1)

1. The Man of God's Faithfulness

- •I charge you
  - •God, who gives life makes alive or preserves life -> 'no need to fear death'
  - •The good confession see John 18:33-38
    - In the face of death, Jesus did not waver from or compromise the truth
    - •Model / example (1 Pet. 2:21-25)

- 1. The Man of God's Faithfulness
- Keep the commandment
  - •Which commandment? Only one?
    - 1. The instructions given in 6:11-12
      - •Flee, pursue, fight, take hold
    - 2. His commission (see 1 Tim. 1:1, 18)
      - •Can mean charge, instruction, direction (see Acts 17:15)

- 1. The Man of God's Faithfulness
- Keep the commandment
  - •Which commandment? Only one?
    - 3. The Gospel (see 1 John 3:23; 2 John 6; 2 Pet. 2:21; 3:2; cf. John 12:49-50)
      - The Law of Christ (1 Cor. 9:21; Gal. 6:2)
      - •Man of God is always associated with the word of God (cf. 2 Tim. 3:16-17)

- 1. The Man of God's Faithfulness
- Keep the commandment
  - •Keep protect, guard
  - Without stain unblemished (external -> conduct; see 2 Pet. 3:14)
  - 2. Without reproach unrebukable; blameless irreprehensible (1 Tim. 3:2; 5:7; cf. 3:7, 10; 5:14)

- 1. The Man of God's Faithfulness
- Keep the commandment
  - •Keep protect, guard
  - 3. Until the appearing of our Lord the Second Advent (2 Thess. 2:1-11; Titus 2:13; 2 Pet. 3:3-4)
    - •Culmination of the 'times of the Gentiles' (Luke 21:24-28; Rom. 11:25-27)

- 2. The God of Man
- Gives life to all things
  - •He is the Creator (Gen. 1:1)
    - •See Neh. 9:5-6
  - •He is the Sustainer (Ps. 121:1-2; Acts 14:17)
  - •He gives new life (John 5:21)



- 2. The God of Man
- The blessed and only Sovereign
  - Sovereign possessor of power or authority; absolute ruler
    - •He alone is God (Isa. 43:10-13)
    - •In charge! "which He will bring about at the proper time"
      - Power, authority, wisdom, ability

- 2. The God of Man
- The blessed and only Sovereign
  - •Blessed content, fulfilled, happy (Gen. 14:19-20; Ps. 41:13)
    - •And He blesses (Ps. 40:4; Matt. 5:3-11)
  - •Only He has no rival or equal (Isa. 44:6-8; Deut. 4:35, 39; Ps. 18:31)
    - His will/plan cannot be thwarted

# 2. The God of Man

- The blessed and only Sovereign
  - King of kings and Lord of lords
    - •See 1 Tim. 1:17
    - •OT: cf. Deut. 10:17; Ps. 136:2-3
    - •NT also of Jesus (Rev. 17:14; 19:16)
      - Points to Jesus' deity



- 2. The God of Man
- Who alone possesses immortality
  - Without death; deathlessness
  - God is unable to die because He inherently possesses life (John 5:26)
    - •But He does share it (1 Cor. 15:53-54)
  - •Cf. 1 Tim. 1:17 immortal = incorruptible exempt from wear, waste, decay

- 2. The God of Man
- Dwells in unapproachable light
  - •Utterly holy; inaccessible to man
    - •We only know Him because He has revealed Himself to us (cf. Rom. 1:19-20)
    - •We can only approach Him through His Mediator (1 Tim. 2:5)

- 2. The God of Man
- Dwells in unapproachable light
  - ·Whom no man has seen or can see.
  - Not apprehended by the senses (John 1:18)
  - •We cannot see Him as He is (Ex. 33:19-20)
    - •But won't the pure in heart see God? (Matt. 5:8; cf. 1 Cor. 13:12)
      - Limited to what we can handle

- 2. The God of Man
- To Him be honor
  - Respect, reverence, esteem
- To Him be eternal dominion
  - Manifested power, power in action (see 1 Pet. 5:5-11)
- •Amen truly; so be it



### So What?

- •We have been given a great task: 🔄
  - To preserve the gospel
    - The whole purpose of God (Acts 20:27)
    - Without stain or reproach
    - Do not add to it or take away from it (cf. Deut. 4:2; 12:32; Prov. 30:5-6; Rev. 22:18)

### So What?

- •We have been given a great task: 🔄
  - To proclaim the gospel
    - •God desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth (2:4)
    - •Make disciples (Matt. 28:19-20)
    - •Be ready to give a defense for the hope you have (1 Pet. 3:15)

## So What?

- •2 Pet. 1:2-3; 3:17-18
  - True knowledge of God should motivate us to pursue godliness
    - •God gives life! -> Don't fear death
    - God is Sovereign! -> Don't worry
    - God is blessed! -> Don't be discouraged
    - God is holy! -> Pursue righteousness
