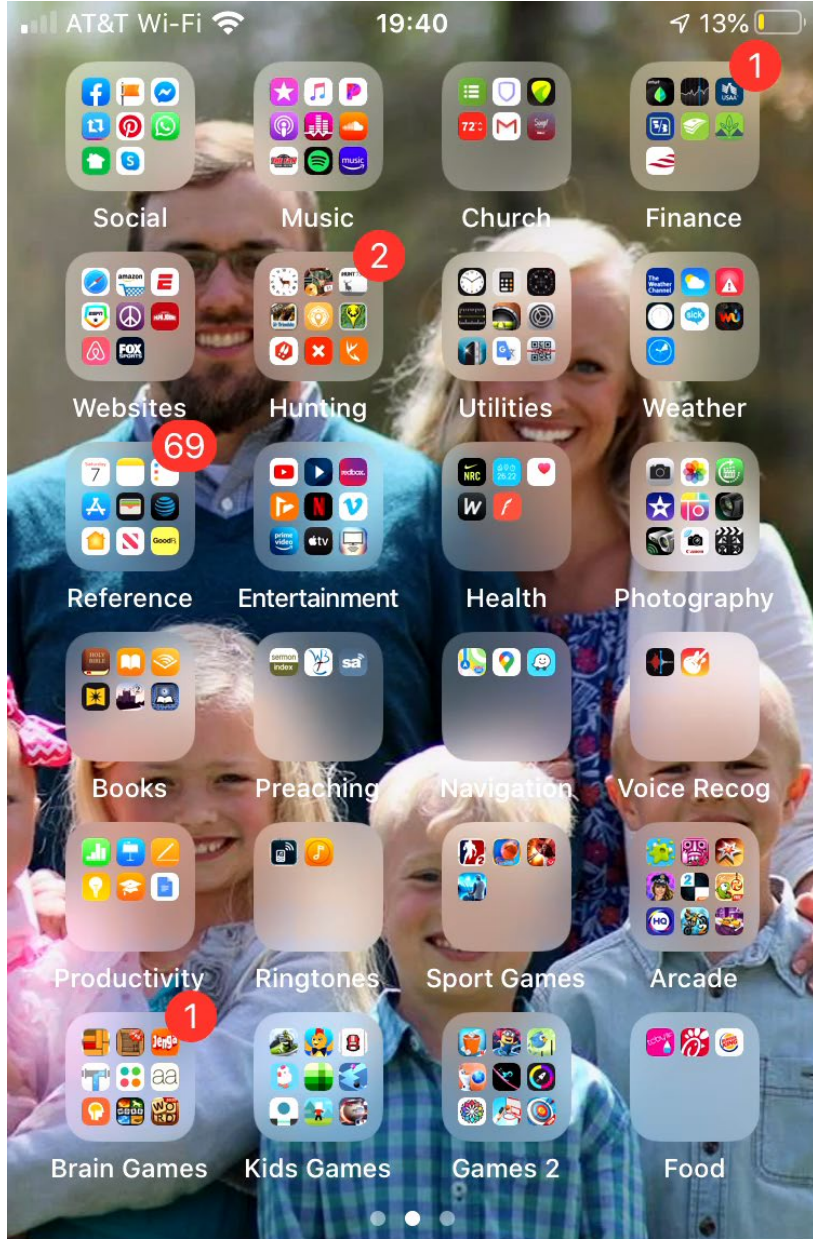

Deut. 18:15

The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from you countrymen, you shall listen to him.



Deut. 34:10
