# 2020 Congregational Meeting Follow-Up

From the Elders and Deacons:

We really appreciate everyone's involvement in the annual meeting and the flexibility with technology to make it all happen. This was probably the best-attended meeting we have had in a few years. Having the flexibility of Webex likely helped folks to attend, regardless of their location.

### Meeting make-up:

97 members on the active member list

31 members in person (IP)

13 members absentee vote

29 members via Webex

73 total members participating (75%), which is well above our required 50% active members present to have a quorum.

The highlighted items below represent the additional wording added during the meeting as part of the discussion prior to the final vote for each item.

### Item: Annual Budget

73 yes – 0 no approved

### **Building Item 1: Revised wording**

We, the Waxhaw Bible Church family, believe the best way we can steward the resources God has entrusted to us is to replace the 3 existing modular buildings with a permanent foundation-based replacement.

72 yes – 1 no Approved

### **Building Item 2: Revised wording**

We will set an initial capital goal of \$500k (proposed) as a threshold. Once our building fund has reached a balance of \$500k, the leadership may begin the formal process of pursuing a loan, if necessary, leaving approximately \$900k (which is about 3x our annual general budget), which is based on the current proposed building plan. (The congregation will separately need to approve the loan terms, once negotiated.)

67 yes - 6 no

Approved (the threshold for approval is 2/3 of members present voting yes, so for this meeting 49 needed for approval. We had 91.7% yes)
